We need medical supplies, such as ace bandages, Band-aids, gauze, tape, disinfectants, hand sanitizer, etc. We need over-the-counter medications such as Advil, Tylenol, children's Tylenol, topical medications, etc. We are also in need of prosthetic limbs or supplies to create limbs.

We have physicians, nurses, physical therapists, occupational therapists, translators, and support staff who use their personal vacation and pay their own way for each of our medical trips. In addition, we are looking for nurses and therapists who would be willing to spend additional time living and working in our clinic and teaching students the basics of rehabilitation medicine.
